2025 (January – December; 12 months; 52 weeks; 365 days)

Residents of Marion County (Jan-Dec)

891 abortions/52 weeks = 17.13 abortions/week AVERAGE

Residents of Polk County (Jan-Dec)

136 abortions/52 weeks = 2.62 abortions/week AVERAGE

Summary: Marion & Polk in 2025 January – December

**Weekly average (1,027 from Marion & Polk)/52= 19.75 abortions/week AVERAGE
Marion & Polk**

= over 19/week AVERAGE

**Daily average (1,027 from Marion & Polk)/365 = 2.81 abortions/day AVERAGE
Marion & Polk**

= over 2/day AVERAGE
